



Summer: Seasons

This book shares how the characters know it is summer! When the sun shines through their window, they jump out of bed, and ice-cold drinks make their tongues tingle! How does your child know if it is summertime? Use a tape or a magnet strip to attach a large, yellow circle to your refrigerator or other surface, making it easy for your child to see—pre-cut ½-inch-wide and 6- to 8-inch-long strips of different colors of construction paper. Every day, ask your child what they did that day that made them know it was summer. Write what they said on each strip and add the strip to the yellow circle as the rays of the sun. Reread your child's reflections every day and see if they want to repeat any of the activities and experiences they told you about!
