

Handprint Holly

Holly is the official flower for the month of December. This beautiful flower is many times used to decorate for the winter holidays. Help your child create their own decorative holly craft! Start with two sheets of different shades of green construction paper. Trace your child's hands, one on each sheet of paper, and cut them out. Place one hand on top of the other but then spread them apart where only the base of the hands stay together. These are the leaves of the plant. Use a small clothespin to hold the hands in place. Then, have your child glue 3 red pompoms around the tip of the clothespin. These are the berries of the plant. You can use this craft as an ornament for your tree; as a gift card to place on presents; or, as an addition to a wreath that your child has made.
