



Insect Bingo

Create a BINGO grid on a large sheet of butcher paper, poster board, or even the back of a large paper bag. The grid will be 4 columns and 4 rows. At the top of the grid, put the letters B-U-G-S across the columns. Let your child help you draw and color different bugs that you see throughout the day- bees, ladybugs, ants, butterflies, even roaches- into each square of the grid. Every day, tell your child to remember any bugs they see, and then let them draw a big X over one bug that they saw each day on the BINGO card. When a row is complete, your child gets to yell “BUGS” and win a special dessert after dinner!



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
