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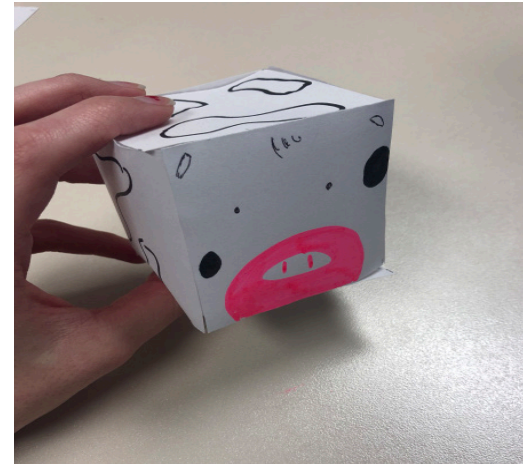
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Cow Cube

Materials Needed:

- 1 Sheet of Poster Board or Construction Paper
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Black and Pink Markers
- Tape

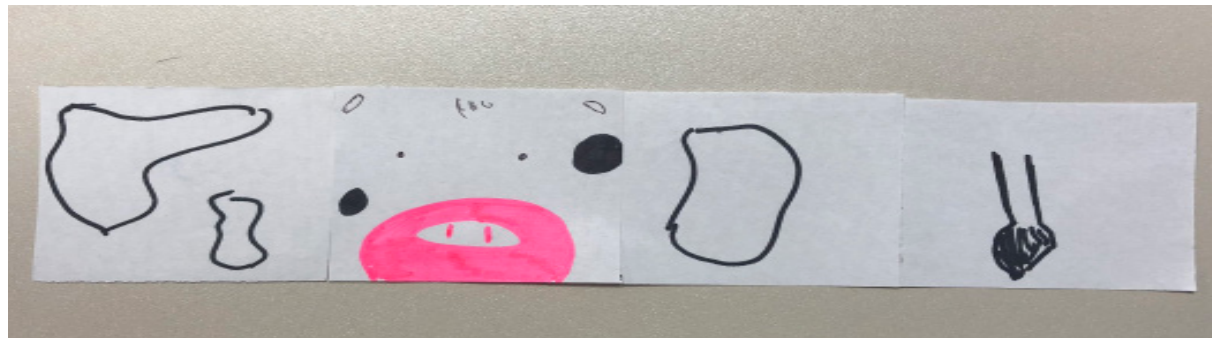


Instructions:

- Using your construction paper and ruler, measure 6 squares that are 6 by 6 centimeters each. Cut these squares out
- On one square, draw a face for your cow, draw a tail on another square, then draw spots on the rest of your squares.

How to put the cube together:

- Using four of the squares, lay them in the corresponding order: Spotted Square, Face Square, Spotted Square, the Tail Square and lay them side by side in a line and then tape them together. Then, tape the first and last square together, to make the 4 squares form a cube
- Tape another spotted square on top, and then the last spotted square to the bottom of the cube.



Rain

Materials Needed:

- Clear Glass or Jar
- Water
- Shaving Cream
- Blue Food Coloring



Instructions:

- Fill Clear Glass or Jar with water (about 3/4)
- Add Shaving Cream to the top of the water (to the top of the glass or jar)
- Now add drops of blue food coloring on top of the shaving cream to make it rain!
