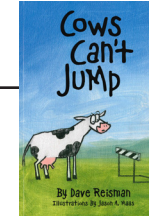

# Sun

## Materials Needed:

- Paper Plate
- Yellow Construction Paper
- Orange Construction Paper
- Glue
- Scissors



## Directions:

- Cover the outside of your paper plate with yellow construction paper
- Trace and cut handprints on yellow and orange construction paper- These handprints will be the sun's rays, make sure to trace enough handprints to be able to cover the outside circle of the paper plate
- Glue your handprints all around the outside circle of your paper plate
- Add a face to your sun!

# Flag Treat

## Ingredients Needed:

- Graham Crackers (1/2 per treat)
- Red And Blue M&Ms
- White Frosting



## Directions:

- Break desired amount of graham crackers in half
- Spread white frosting on each graham cracker half
- Place blue M&M's on top of frosting in the top left handed corner of your graham cracker
- Place red M&M's to make stripes on the rest of the graham cracker- to make it look like the stripes on the flag
