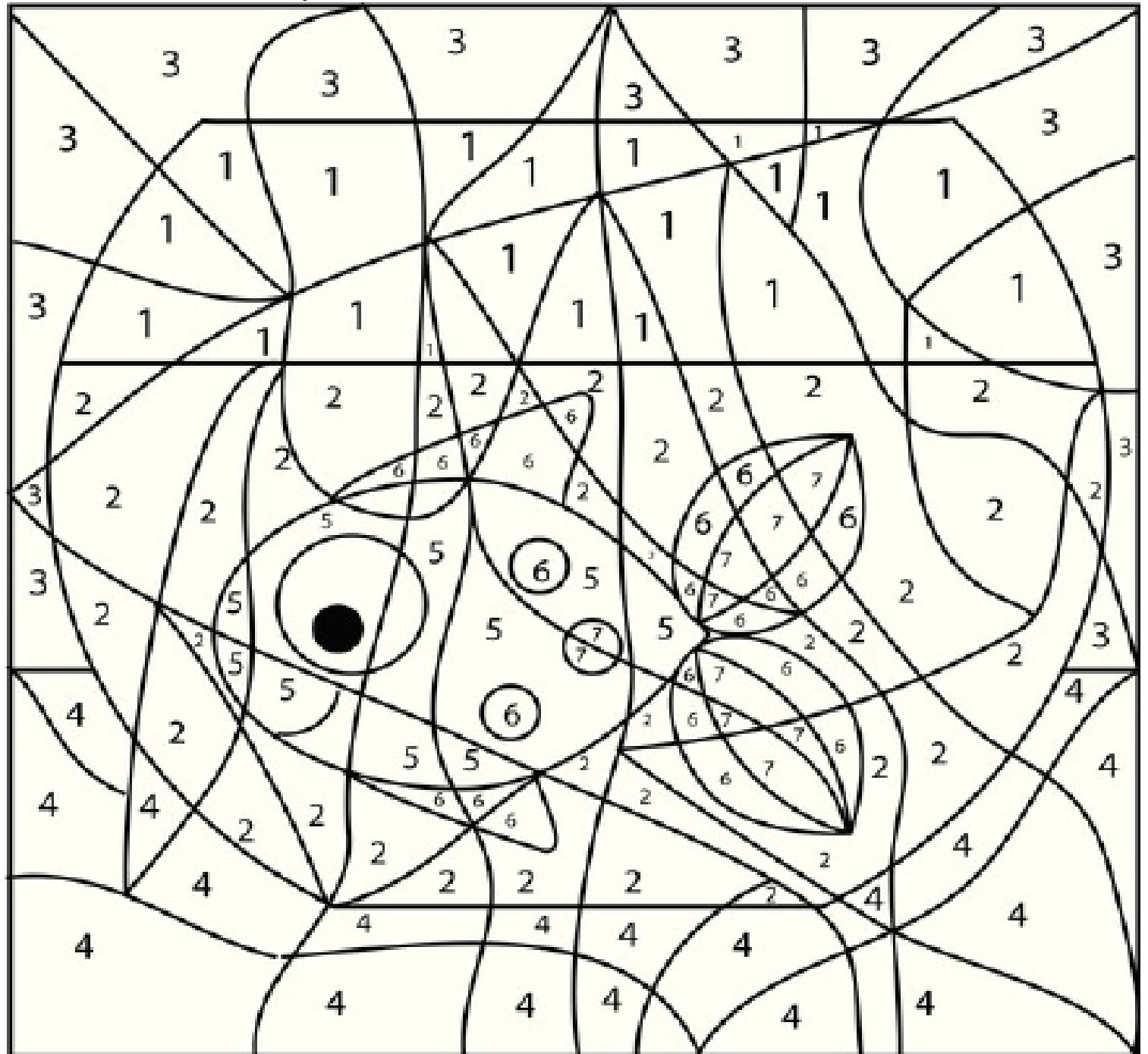

Flamingo

Materials Needed:

- Pink Construction Paper
- Yellow Construction Paper
- Pink Pipe Cleaner
- Black Marker
- Pencil
- Glue
- Scissors



Instructions:

- Trace and cut out your handprint on pink construction paper
- Draw and cut the neck/face of a flamingo, then glue to the back of your handprint
- Glue pipe cleaners to the bottom of the handprint for legs
- Cut out a beak from yellow construction paper
- Draw an eye for the flamingo with a black marker
