After reading the story, use this method of teaching good behaviors on your own child. If they are running in the house or screaming in a restaurant, stop them and say, "Little Dino! You can't run in the house but where can you run?" or "Little Dino! You can't scream inside of a restaurant but where can you scream?" Then, when they run outside or scream going down the hill on their bike, you can say, "That's it, Little Dino! You are *running* or *screaming* at the right time!
