



Make your own Cards

On 2 sets of index cards, write numbers 1 through 10 in the corners of each card. So, one card has the number 1 in all 4 corners, one card has the number 2 in all 4 corners, and so on. Next, bring out some old magazines or books that are no longer in good repair, but most pages are in good condition. Tell your child that they need to search through the magazines and books for the number of items that match the numbers on the cards. So, if a card has the number 3 on it, your child needs to find 3 of the same objects to put on the card, such as 3 cars. If they have trouble finding 3 of the same objects, they can just cut 3 objects to glue on the card, such as 1 car, 1 doll, and 1 apple. When both sets of cards have the correct number of items glued to them, your child can play a matching game where they match each card from one set to the card in the other set that has the same number of items on it. Your child can make up any game they like with the set of cards that they made themselves!
