Flower Frame

Materials Needed:

- Small Paper Plate
- Colored Construction Paper (Your Choice)
- Pipe Cleaner (1 Per Flower Frame)
- Tape
- Glue
- Scissors



Instructions:

- Cut out a hole in the middle of your paper plate
- Cut out petals from colored construction paper and glue to the back of the paper plate
- Glue a pipe cleaner to the bottom of the paper plate
- Tape desired photo to the back of the paper plate- you can change the photo anytime!

Turtle

Materials Needed:

- White Paper Bowl
- Green Marker
- Black Marker
- Green Construction Paper
- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions:

- Flip over and color the outside of a paper bowl (to look like a turtle)
- Cut out four legs and a tail and glue to the underside of the bowl
- Cut out a head and color two eyes, then glue to the underside of the bowl
