


Spider Snack

Ingredients Needed:

- Oreos (1 Per Snack)
- Pretzel Sticks (4 Per Snack)
- M&M's (2 Per Snack)

• Icing



Directions:

- Break 4 Pretzel Sticks in half, then you will have 8 even pretzel sticks
- Place the pretzels into the filling of the Oreo, which will be the legs for your spider
- Use icing to add 2 M&M's on top of the Oreo- which will be the Spider's eyes
- Make as many Spider Snacks as you desire and enjoy!



Paper Pumpkin

Materials Needed:

- Orange Construction Paper
- Black Marker
- Glue
- Scissors
- Ruler

Directions:

- Fold A piece of orange construction paper in half (lengthwise)
- Cut 2 inch slits, from the fold of the paper, the length of the paper (each slit should be made about 1/2 inch apart from each other)
- Unfold the paper and glue the ends together to make the pumpkin
- Draw 2 eyes, a nose, and a mouth on the paper using a marker to make a face for your pumpkin
- Cut a handle from orange construction paper and glue the ends to the inside of the pumpkin
