Paper Apples

Materials Needed:

- Red and Green Construction Paper
- Tissue Paper
- Clear Tape
- Hole Punch
- Scissors

Instructions:

- Cut four even strips of paper- using the red construction paper
- Punch a hole in the middle of each strip of paper
- Stack the strips with the holes all sitting on top of each other- and facing different directions
- Put tissue paper through all of the holes
- Tape the tissue paper to the bottom of the apple
- Join the ends of each strip together- tape the ends together- you now have your apple!
- On your green construction paper draw a leaf and then cut it out and tape it to the top of your apple!
- Cut out Peck and put him in your apple!





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Pumpkin Pretzel Treat

Ingredients Needed:

- Tiny Pretzel Twist
- White Chocolate Chips
- Orange Food Coloring
- Mini Chocolate Chips
- Cookie Sheet
- Forks

Instructions:

- In a microwaveable bowl, melt white chocolate chips- bowl will be hot!
- Add orange food coloring to white chocolate chips, till desired color of orange
- Spread the orange chocolate on each pretzel twist- you can dip the pretzel in the bowl of chocolate and us a fork to coat the whole pretzel, or you can drizzle the chocolate on the pretzel twist
- Dip the bottom of one mini chocolate chip in the orange chocolate and place at the top of the pretzel- this is the pumpkin's stem
- Place coated pretzels on a cookie sheet for the chocolate to set
- Make as many treats as you desire and enjoy!
